FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is there any military obligation?

No, absolutely not. We are prohibited from recruiting for the military. We do provide information to anyone interested and cadets who spend more than a year in JROTC can enter the military at a higher rank.

Do I have to wear a uniform?

Yes, you usually wear the uniform once every two weeks, and for any special ceremonies or events. This usually means wearing it 10-12 times during the school year. Part of wearing the uniform includes adhering to hair and grooming standards.

Do I have to pay for a uniform?

No. JROTC provides you with a clean uniform, books and any other items required. You are required to keep it clean which may require periodic dry cleaning.

Are there any costs?

Yes. We expect each cadet to purchase a Polo Shirt and to participate in fundraising to the extent they are able. Certain events such as military ball & field trips do cost extra. However, we provide multiple fundraising opportunities to help cadets earn money to pay for these events.

<u>Can I be in JROTC and Other</u> Organizations such as Athletics and Band?

Yes, most definitely. On any given year we have cadets who are also in the band, on football, track, basketball, soccer and cross country teams.

What is expected?

We expect cadets to adhere to the standards and abide by the requirements of the program, to try their best in everything and to accept new challenges. There are no height, weight or physical fitness standards that must be met either before entering JROTC or to successfully pass the course.

In addition to receiving one (1) elective credit for each year you take JROTC, after the 1st Year of JROTC, you will also receive credit for Physical Education (.5 credits). Take a 2nd Year and you will receive credit for Health (.5 credits). Take a 3rd and 4th year and you will also receive credit for College & Career Readiness (1.0 credit). ALL of these courses are required for graduation.

We focus on the importance of school and community service. During past years we have supported multiple charitable organizations to include our local food bank where we have donated over 25,000 cans of food. We emphasize and expect cadets to show respect for others, to respect themselves and to take responsibility for their own actions.
